Abolition of the Res Non Dom regime? Current Scenario and Possible Prospects

Starting from April 6, 2025, the United Kingdom may abolish the tax regime for non-domiciled residents (Res Non Dom), replacing it with a new 4-year special regime. From the fifth year onwards, all residents could be subject to ordinary taxation on global income, prompting many taxpayers to consider relocating to countries with more favorable tax regimes.

During the meeting, we will analyze the potential changes of the reform, the relocation opportunities for High Net Worth Individuals (HNWI) to Switzerland and Italy, which offer similar flat-tax regimes, and the latest updates based on the UK Government's stance.
